Post Doctoral Psychology Fellow

I. QUALIFICATIONS

Ph.D. or Psy.D. in Psychology, Applied Behavior Analysis, or related field.

II. SUPERVISION/REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

The Post Doctoral Psychology Fellow will report to the Licensed Psychologist who will provide all supervision requirements necessary for licensure as a psychologist in the state of MA. Secondary supervision will be available by other doctoral level behavior analysts and/or school psychologists.

III. RESPONSIBILITIES

The Post Doctoral Psychology Fellow will participate in early intervention diagnostic screenings, neurodevelopmental assessments, neuropsychological evaluations, educational consultations, and psychological assessments under the guidance and supervision of the licensed psychologist. This will be done in an apprentice model of training for the testing portion of the fellowship.

#### Behavioral Intervention Responsibilities:

Post Doctoral Fellow in psychology will deliver a planned and coordinated program of behavioral services. Fellow will be trained in the general principles of applied behavior analysis (ABA), including the development of individual goals and objectives to be included in treatment plans, written guidelines for behavioral interventions, and data collection procedures for behavior programs.

The postdoctoral fellow will also be responsible for participation in meetings for all individuals on assigned caseloads, informing assigned supervisor of all team meeting dates and times as they are scheduled to facilitate supervisory attendance at these meetings, and communicating any treatment or family concerns to immediate supervisor in a timely manner.

The postdoctoral fellow will also have the opportunity to attend the Cambridge College graduate studies program in ABA. This will provide a 6 course sequence and make the candidate eligible to become a Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA).
